## ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT

I agree to support Harvest Christian Academy (HCA) in the following areas.

In the case of early disenrollment before the school year is over, I understand that the **enrollment fee and curriculum fee are non-refundable**. In most cases these costs will have already been incurred and therefore are non-refundable. Fees that **are** reimbursable upon early disenrollment is the tuition and is determined by figuring what percentage of the year is left (round down to nearest week) and refunding that portion of the tuition back. If the student has not taken the standardized test then the standardized test fee will be refunded.

Tuition payments that fall behind 60 days or more will result in the student(s) being disenrolled from the school unless other arrangements have been made and agreed upon by the administration.

**Curriculum:** We use 2 different Christian Based Curriculums at HCA: Alpha Omega Publications(AOP) and Accelerated Christian Education (ACE). We will test your child at enrollment to determine the level at which they are working. We have found that our AOP curriculum is

advanced and it is uncommon for transfer students to be placed in the curriculum at grade level. Please do not be alarmed that most of our transfer students place 1-2 years below grade level in our curriculum. If they test below age/grade level they will be started at the grade level of curriculum where they tested, however they will remain in the grade their peers are in. We will then do our best to bring them up to age/grade level work as this may take several years.

**Involvement:** The tuition fees we charge are just enough to meet our basic expenses. Because of this we need to rely upon volunteer help and the involvement of parents in the school.
