USING THE ABOVE GUIDELINES WE GLADLY ALLOW THE FOLLOWING

EVERYONE

SWEATSHIRTS, VESTS, JACKETS AND SWEATERS:
 With dress code underneath
 Hoods up only outside

PANTS:
 Jeans, cords, chinos, khakis, cargo, slacks

SHOES:
 Sandals with heel strap
 Tennis shoes
 Dress shoes or boots

HAT AND SUNGLASSES OUTSIDE ONLY

SPECIFIC TO BOYS

COLLARED SHIRTS:
 Polos or button down

SEASONAL DRESS SHORTS:
 AUGUST—OCTOBER & MAY, JUNE

HAIR:
 Collar or shorter in back
 Above ears and eyebrows

CLEAN SHAVEN:
 Side burns trimmed to middle of ear

SPECIFIC TO GIRLS

DRESSES AND SKIRTS:
 Modest length

BLOUSES AND SHIRTS:
 Cover shoulder
 Cover stomach when arms are raised

LEGGINGS AND TIGHT FITTING PANTS:
 Permissible under a skirt or dress

CAPRIS:
 No shorts

SPECIFIC TO PRESCHOOL—2nd GRADE

SAME AS DRESS CODE BUT T-SHIRTS ARE OK

SPECIFIC TO PHYSICAL EDUCATION

APPROPRIATE CLOTHES FOR PE
CLEAN EACH WEEK
ATHLETIC PANTS OR MID-THIGH ATHLETIC SHORTS
ATHLETIC SHOES AND SOCKS
T-SHIRTS
 No Tank tops or muscle shirts
NO ~ SPANDEX
